



Texas FFA State Convention

Validation Tag ordes are just around the corner. Lamb and Goat tags will have the first deadline followed by barrow and heifer tag orders. If you plan on feeding lambs or goats for validation please read this information before placing an order. You will select from a list of options and enter the number of tags you are ordering. The options include

Market Lamb or Goat; Breeding Sheep or Goat (Registered), and, whether dam (lamb) or whether doe (goat). Be advised that ALL ewes or does must order the corresponding tag and validate accordingly.
