





#### July 7 - 10:

Final steer closeout weights.

#### July 10:

Steers delivered at the Amarillo Livestock Auction for check-in by noon.

#### July 15:

Digital record book due and emailed by 5:00 p.m.

#### July 24:

Contest Day at West Texas A&M University

Junior/Senior participants check in from 7:30 a.m. to 7:50 a.m.

Contest begins at 8:00 a.m. Winners to be announced that afternoon following the contest.


