

Major Show Entries will be due November 10<sup>th</sup>. You must be paid up before you enter shows and entry fees are due at the time of entry Schedules have changed at San Antonio and Houston



- Now is the time to get books uptodate. Deadline is March 31.
- Must meet the following :
- 1. Must have records to document experiences, time, and money
- 2. must have completed ten (10) activities from three different activity areas above the chapter level.
- 3. Must have an approved SAE and show growth
- 4. Twenty-five (25) hours of community service within at least two different community service activities
- 5. candidates must have earned and productively invested \$1,000 as a result of his or her own efforts in an agricultural experience program
- 6. Serve as a chapter, district, or Area Officer
- 7. Demonstrate the ability to use parliamentary procedure and present a speech
- 1<sup>st</sup> Draft Applications due March 31. Will you earn your degree in Dallas next summer?

#### WHO NEEDS TO PARTICIPATE?

- ALL YOUTH WHO WOULD LIKE TO EXHIBIT A SHOW ANIMAL
- ALL NEW 4-H/FFA MEMBERS NEED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LEARNING MODULE AND PASS THE EXAM WITH A SCORE OF 80% OR HIGHER BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR SHOW ENTRY FORMS

#### WHEN DO WE NEED TO RETAKE THE QUALITY COUNTS EXAM?

- . IF YOU DID NOT PASS THE EXAM WITH A SCORE OF 80% OR HIGHER
- . IF YOU ARE MOVING INTO 3RD GRADE
- . IF YOU ARE MOVING FROM 5TH GRADE TO 6TH GRADE
- IF YOU ARE MOVING FROM 8TH GRADE TO 9TH GRADE

New Exhibitors, 6<sup>th</sup> Grade, and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Exhibitors <u>MUST COMPLETE</u> the Quality Counts Program prior to entering major shows! If its not completed by November 10, yu cannot enter the major shows!
